- ☐ Light jacket or scarf — *the venue may be cold due to air conditioning*

IMPORTANT: AM/FM radios will NOT be provided at the venue. If you require Mandarin translation, you must bring your own AM/FM radio receiver and earphones (a physical device — not a radio app on your mobile phone), plus spare batteries or a power bank for charging.

Photography, audio recording and video recording are strictly prohibited throughout the event.

This is an invitation-only event. Each registration is personal and non-transferable.

Full Attendance Required

Participants are required to attend the event in full, for the entire duration of the programme.

Adult Participants Only

This event is intended for adult participants only. Children's programmes or childcare services will not be provided.

Practical Information

Mandarin Simultaneous Translation

Available via AM/FM radio. The frequency may be adjusted on the day depending on hall conditions. Please bring your own **AM/FM radio receiver and earphones (physical device — not a radio app on your mobile phone)**, plus **spare batteries or a power bank** — these will NOT be provided at the venue.

Power outlets will not be available in the hall, so please ensure your device has sufficient battery life before arriving.

Meals

Not provided during the programme. Vegetarian meals are not required.

IOI City Mall offers a wide variety of cafés, restaurants and dining options for participants' convenience. No eating or drinking (apart from tsok and water) in the venue hall.

Water

Water dispensers will be available at the venue. Please bring your own **water bottle or thermos**.

Seating

Chair seating will be provided throughout the programme. No need to bring meditation cushions.

Dress Code

No specific dress code. Respectful, comfortable attire is recommended. Please bring a light jacket or scarf as the venue may be cold due to air conditioning.

Transportation

- Approx. 30–45 minutes by car from KLIA
- **Grab** is the recommended mode of transport
- No convenient public transportation directly serves the venue
- Parking available at IOI City Mall; standard charges apply

First Time in Malaysia?

A few tips for international participants visiting for the first time.

About Malaysia

Malaysia is a multiracial country — Malay, Chinese, Indian, and many indigenous communities live together, each with their own languages, customs, religions, and festivals. Malay is the national language, though English, Mandarin, Cantonese and Hokkien are also widely spoken — so language is rarely a barrier for visitors.

Entry Requirements

- Visa requirements vary by nationality — check Malaysia's official immigration site before booking travel: www.imi.gov.my

- All foreign visitors (with few exceptions) must also complete the Malaysia Digital Arrival Card (MDAC) — free, mandatory, separate from any visa — within 3 days before arrival: [imigresen-online.imi.gov.my/mdac/main](https://online.imi.gov.my/mdac/main) (free — beware of unofficial sites charging a fee)

Money & Payments

- Local currency: **Ringgit Malaysia (RM / MYR)**. Credit cards (Visa, Mastercard) are widely accepted; Alipay works via DuitNow QR; WeChat Pay acceptance is more limited
- ATMs and money changers are available at the airport and at IOI City Mall

Getting Connected & Around

- August weather: **27–34°C (80–93°F) daytime, 24–26°C (75–79°F) at night**, with possible rain.
- WiFi will NOT be provided at the venue — bring an eSIM (e.g. Airalo) or get a local prepaid SIM (CelcomDigi or Hotlink Maxis) at KLIA or IOI City Mall
- **Grab** (ride-hailing and food delivery app, like Uber) is the easiest way to get around — download the app before you arrive
- Malaysia uses **Type G plugs** (UK-style, 3-pin, 230V) — bring an adaptor if needed

Frequently Asked Questions

When should I arrive?

We recommend arriving on 11 August 2026 to complete registration. The programme begins on the morning of 12 August 2026.

When does the programme end?

The programme is expected to conclude around lunchtime on 18 August 2026.

Is the daily schedule available?

Kindly refer to the *Registration & Schedule* file

Am I required to attend every day?

Yes. Participants are required to attend the event in full, for the entire duration of the programme.

Are children allowed?

No. To help create a supportive and conducive environment, this event is intended for adult participants only. A children's camp and childcare support will not be offered for this event.

Do I need to bring my registration confirmation?

Yes. Please bring your registration confirmation email with QR code for check-in at the event. If you have not received your confirmation email, kindly contact malaysia2026@siddharthasintent.org.

Do I need to bring an AM/FM radio?

Yes, if you require Mandarin simultaneous translation. Please bring your own AM/FM radio receiver and earphones — use a physical device, not a radio app on your mobile phone. The frequency used may be adjusted on the day. Spare batteries or a power bank are essential, as power outlets will not be available in the hall. AM/FM radios will NOT be provided at the venue.

Do I need to bring a meditation cushion?

No. Chair seating will be provided throughout the programme.

What should I wear?

There is no specific dress code. Respectful, comfortable attire is recommended. Please bring a light jacket or scarf, as the venue may be cold due to air conditioning.

How do I get to the venue?

Grab is the recommended mode of transportation. The venue is approximately 30–45 minutes from KLIA. There is no convenient public transportation directly serving the venue. Participants driving may park at IOI City Mall, where standard charges apply.
